Date	October 8, 2017
Issue	Education, Parenting
Program	At about 6:30 am, we ran an 8 ½ minute interview with Suzanne Bouffard, PhD, about the importance of pre-school programs, and about how children that attend a quality pre-K program have better outcomes later in school. She also said they learn self control and offered advice for parents on how to choose a quality school.

Date	October 15, 2017
Issue	1 st Amendment, Employment
Program	At about 6:30 am, we ran a 7 and 1/2 minute interview with Michael Schmidt about how social media blunders can cost people their jobs. He also talked about rules employers can formulate, and how to protect the company while not infringing on the rights of the employee.

Program	At about 6:30 am, we ran a 9 minute interview with Elliot Haut, MD, FACS, about how recent studies found victims of gun trauma were less like to die when transported for treatment by private vehicle, and the possible reasons behind this.
