Issue	Personal Finance, Women's Issues
Program	At about 6:30 am, we ran a 10 and ½ minute interview with author Meredith Jones about how women's and men's investments differ, and offered advice to women considering a career as an investment professional.

Date	March 11, 2018
Issue	Renewable Energy, Pollution, Government Infrastructure
Program	At about 6:45 am, we ran an 8 1/2 minute interview with Ken Caldeira, Ph.D., about how wind and solar energy could generate up to 80% of U.S. Energy needs, and outlined the ways that energy providers must generate electricity by other means when renewable sources falter.

Date	March 18, 2018
Issue	Military Issues, Mental Health, Suicide
Program	At about 6:30 am, we ran a 7 ½ minute interview with Howard Waitzkin, M.D., Ph.D., about how many active duty military personnel are making extensive use of private mental health services because they're dissatisfied with the quality of military care and are worried about reprisals from their command. He also discussed outside help that is available nationwide.

Issue	Traffic Safety, Government Regulation, Technology
Program	At about 6:30 am, we ran a 9 minute interview with Missy Cummings, Ph.D., about the safety of automated vehicles, and whether technology is ready for high speed or congested environments. She said voluntary safety testing is inadequate, and greater government oversight is needed.
