Date	June 1st, 2018
Issue	Free Summer Lunch Program, Summer Camps at YMCA
Program	At about 9:05 am, we ran a 6:27 interview with the YMCA's Operating Director John Barber and Marketing Director Chris Blakeslee about the summer camps available, some with tutoring, and the free summer lunch programs available at locations throughout the city.

Date	June 5 th through June 19, 2018
Issue	Age-related Macular Degeneration
Program	We ran a 30 second announcement at least once a day from the Foundation Fighting Blindness about how macular degeneration is the leading cause of blindness in older adults, how it can be slowed and in some cases reversed.

Program	We ran a 30 second announcement at least once a day for Solitude Lake Management about herbicide treatment on the lake. The announcement advised residents of where the treatment would take place, that residents and animals should stay out of the water, and who to contact to see maps of treatment areas.

Issue	Free Rabies Clinics
